| Upon the completion of this lesson, <br> Students will be able to: <br> Revise the alphabet Aa-Gg <br> Write capital and small letters Aa to Gg | Recap:Students will be welcomed in new class. Introduce yourself and encourage students to introduce themselves one by one. <br> We Are Learning to: Identify letters Aa-Gg, their sounds, vocabulary and formation. <br> What I am looking for: How well you identify the letter, their sound vocabulary and formation. <br> Gained skill: This will help us to improve our listening, speaking and reading, writing skills. <br> Introduction:Teacher will play abc song video: <br> $\mathrm{https}: / / y o u t u$ be/hq3yfQnllfQ <br> Tell students today we are going to revise our letters Aa-Gg. Show letters Aa-Gg randomly and ask their names and sounds. Encourage students to tell at least 3 words with shown letter e.g. d dolphin, doughnut, and dice. Write capital letters A-G on one side of board and small letters $a-g$ on the other side of board. Encourage them to come and match capital letter with small letter. Ask students to write letters $A a$ to $G g$ in the air repeatedly for few minutes. A fewstudents can be asked to come up and write the letters on the board. <br> Guided practice: Write letters Aa-Gg on large index cards. Be sure to put the capital letter on one side and small on the other. <br> - Spread the alphabet out on the floor. <br> - Have the children create a circle around the alphabet. <br> - As the teacher plays an upbeat tempo of music (any choice), the children "March around the Alphabet". <br> - Instruct the children to freeze, bend down, and pick up a letter near their toes when the music stops. <br> - Now the children hold their letter cards way up high and wait for the teacher to call upon them to tell what letter they have in their hands. <br> Focused Task:Ask students to open their copies and write letters Aa-Gg with correct formation. <br> Wrap up:Sing abc song with students <br> Reflection: <br> Homework: C.W is H.W | 5 mins | Students will be assessed on Identifying alphabet Aa-Zz <br> Write letters Aa to Gg | Flash cards |
