| Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to: <br> Identified the name, sound, action, vocabulary and formation of capital letter Q | Recap: Teacher will show flashcards of letter ' $q$ ' and all vocabulary words. <br> We Are Learning to: Identify the letter $Q_{q}$ its sound, action and its related vocabulary. Formation of letter $Q$ with a correct sequence of movement <br> What I am looking for: How well you identify the capital letter $Q$ and its vocabulary. <br> Gained skill: This will help us to improve our listening, speaking, reading skills. Introduction: <br> Show the flashcard of capital letter 'Q' ask letter name. Invite students whose name begins with letter $Q$ to come to the front of the class. Next ask their names and write on board and tell them that all written names begin with capital letter and the other items begin with small letters. Ask students to write capital $Q$ in the air. Use the capital letter $Q$ formation such as big circle to the left, short line out. Give ample opportunity to write capital $Q$ in air before tracing. | Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to: <br> Identify the name, sound, action, vocabulary and letter formation of capital and small letter " $\mathrm{Qq}^{\prime}$ " | Recap: Show the flashcard of small letter ' $q$ ' and ask which letter is this? Ask sound. Show the flashcard of capital letter $Q$ ask its sound and its vocabulary words. <br> We Are Learning to: Identify the letter $Q q$, its sound, action and its related vocabulary. Formation of capital and small letter $Q q$ with a correct sequence of movement <br> What I am looking for: How well you identify the letter $Q q$ sound, action and its vocabulary. <br> Gained skill: This will help us to improve our listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. <br> Introduction: <br> Show them the pictures of the patchwork quilts and talk about the way the small squares have been put together to make a large pattern. Tell them we use the quilt in winters to keep us warm. Write capital and small letter " $\mathrm{Qq}_{q}$ " in the air and ask students to observe and guess what you are writing. Encourage students to use small and capital " Qq " words. Show letter " Qq " vocabulary words through ppt and ask students to revise all words. | Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to: <br> Identify the name, sound, action, vocabulary and formation of small and capital letter " $Q_{q}$ ". | Recap: Show the flashcard of small letter ' $q$ ' and ask which letter is this? Ask sound. Show the flashcard of capital letter 'Q'. Recall all vocabulary through flashcards. <br> We Are Learning to: Identify the letter $Q q$ its sound, action and its related vocabulary. Formation of small and capital $Q_{q}$ with a correct sequence of movement. <br> What I am looking for: How well you identify the letter $Q_{q}$ sound, action and its vocabulary. <br> Gained skill: This will help us to improve our listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. <br> Introduction: <br> Organize sand letter prior to tracing letter ' Qq ' on the copy. Demonstrate how to trace the letter using the index and the middle finger. Ask them to trace it 2, 3 times. Revise all the previous three letter words with the help of flash cards.
