<p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>identify about Mosque and its importance</p>	<p><b>Start up:</b> Begin Lesson with dua for going out from house. Ask about names of Allah.</p> <p><b>We Are Learning to:</b> identify about mosque and its importance in our lives.</p> <p><b>What I am looking for:</b> How well you understand the importance of mosque.</p> <p><b>Gained skill:</b> This will help us to understand the significance of worship of Allah.</p> <p><b>Introduction:</b> play this video: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=PjHNNPwfOWA">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=PjHNNPwfOWA</a></p> <p>Show the picture of a mosque and write the word on board. Ask students do you know what place is this? Have you ever gone there with your father? Have you heard the Azaan? Do you know why Azaan is given? For whom Muslims pray? Tell that this is a mosque. Mosque is a place where Muslims go for prayers five times a day. Many mosques have a tall tower where the <i>muezzin</i>, a Muslim crier, stands at the top to call people to five prayers a day. Muslims pray for Allah. Inside the building is a prayer hall, which is a large space where Muslims sit on the floor to pray. Ask students to visit nearby mosque with their father for coming Jummah prayer.</p> <p><b>Focused practice:</b></p> <p>Take prints (according to class strength) of worksheet given in resources. Ask students to help Kareem and Aliyah find their way to mosque. Ask students to open book page 8. Guide them to cut the sticker from page no 75 and paste over here.</p> <p><b>Wrap up:</b> ask questions: Where do we go for prayer? How many times Muslims go to mosque? <p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>identify about khana Kaaba and its importance</p>	<p><b>Start up:</b> Begin Lesson with dua for going out from house. Ask questions like where do Muslims go for prayer? For whom Muslims do pray?</p> <p><b>We Are Learning to:</b> identify about khana Kaaba and its significance.</p> <p><b>What I am looking for:</b> How well you understand the importance of House of Allah.</p> <p><b>Gained skill:</b> This will help us to understand the significance of worship of Allah.</p> <p><b>Introduction:</b> play this video: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=X2yHSIQOZBw">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=X2yHSIQOZBw</a></p> <p>Show the picture of kaaba and ask its name. Tell students that house of Allah is called khana kaaba. The kaaba was first built by Hazrat Adam, peace be upon him. Khana kaaba is located in Makkah. Muslims performs ha j j at kaaba during the month of Dhul-Hijjah. Muslims from all over the world travel to Makkah to perform Ha j j/Umrah. Some travel by planes, some travel by train, and even some even travel by foot! Even though they all speak different languages, they look differently and come from different places, during Ha j j, they all wear white and do the exact same thing in obedience to Allah. Tell students that there is only one kaaba on the earth.</p> <p><b>Focused practice:</b> Ask students to open book page 9 and colour the picture. Provide them black paper bits to cover kaaba on book page 10.</p> <p><b>Wrap up:</b> Ask questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Who built the Kaaba?</li> <li>2. If you want to see the Kaaba, where would you go? Where is the Kaaba?</li> <li>3. How many times does Ha j j come in the year?</li> <li>4. <p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>learn about the Holy book Quran</p>	<p><b>Start up:</b> Begin Lesson with dua for going out from house. Ask questions like where do Muslims go for Hajj? Where is khana kaana located?</p> <p><b>We Are Learning to:</b> identify about Holy book Quran and steps of ablution.</p> <p><b>What I am looking for:</b> How well you understand the importance of Holy book Quran and steps of ablution</p> <p><b>Gained skill:</b> This will help us to understand the significance of worship of Allah.</p> <p><b>Introduction:</b> play this video: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6w-dtXYX-04">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6w-dtXYX-04</a></p> <p>Ask students that have you seen your mother/father/ grandparents reciting Quran? Have you heard the word Quran before? Tell students that is the Holy book of Islam. Allah has sent three more books before Quran. Their names are Torah, Zabur, and In jil. The last book name is Quran. The Quran was revealed on Prophet PBUH by Hazrat Gabriel.</p> <p>Tell students that the holy Quran is written in Arabic language. There are 30 paras and 114 surah in Holy Quran. We should keep ourselves clean before reciting Quran and prayers. Allah tells Muslims a way to keep ourselves clean that called Ablution. Ablution means Wudu. Tell them the steps of Wudu.</p> <p><b>Focused practice:</b></p> <p>Ask students to open book page 11 and ask to trace the dotted name and read its spelling aloud. Provide the worksheet and ask them to match the number with correct wudu steps.</p> <p><b>Wrap up:</b> Ask questions: 1. In which language is the holy Quran written? 2. How many paras of the holy Quran are there? 3. How many Surahs are there is the holy Quran? 4. What should we do before reciting Quran? 5.
