Repeat the dua of going to sleep again and again that students can learn</p> <p></p> <p>We Are Learning to: memorize and recite Bismillah (tasmiyah).</p> <p>What I am looking for: How well you memorize bismillah and implement on it.</p> <p>Gained skill: This will help us to improve our knowledge about Islamic values</p> <p>Introduction: play this video: Play video and sing with students https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IWPY_lyZG50</p> <p>Show the flash card of Bismillah. Tell students that we all are Muslims. Allah has told us a way to start any work and that is to recite . Recite bismillah 3 to 4 times and ask students to repeat it after you. Before bismillah we recite tauz. Ask do you recite this before eating meal? Wait for students responses. Tell them that we should recite bismillah before doing any good deed such as eating meal, reciting Quran, offer prayer, before study time etc. Tell students that Bismillah means In the name of Allah By reading Bismillah, we seek Allah blessing for our work..</p> <p>Focused practice: practice reciting bismillah by providing candies to all students. Ask them what should we do before eating something? Ask them to recite bismillah before eating candy. Ask them to open book page 15. <p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>learn when to say Alhamdulillah as praising and thanking Allah</p>	<p>Start Up: Begin with dua before lesson. Repeat the dua of going to sleep again and again that students can learn</p> <p></p> <p>Ask student to recite tauz and tasmiyah.</p> <p>We Are Learning to: Identify when and why to say Alhumdulillah.</p> <p>What I am looking for: how often you say Alhumdulillah for his blessings.</p> <p>Gained skill: This will help us to improve our knowledge about Islamic values</p> <p>Introduction: Show them the thanks to Allah song.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=om_jgwwd9glQ Tell students today we are going to learn how to be thankful to Allah for his countless blessings. Tell them Allah gave us lot of blessings like our parents, hand ,face and all body parts, food , water, air. Ask the students we should Thankful to Allah for everything in our lives like Allah gave us brain to think and explore, Allah gave us all blessings which we need, and Allah gave us beautiful world to live. Allah gave us everything. We should thankful every time by saying Alhumdulillah. Say Alhumdulillah 3 to 4 times and ask students to repeat after you. Tell them that 'Alhumdulillah means 'to thanks Allah' .Before lunch time ask students do prayer and say Thanks to Allah that He gave us food. Ask students to tell one things on that they want to say Alhumdulillah. Explain like I say Alhumdulillah for my mother.</p> <p>Focused practice: ask students to open book page 18.what is happening in the pictures. What should we say when we finish our food? Who give us food? Help them to do page 19 by cutting pictures from page 67 and paste here to shoe when Muslims say Alhumdulillah.</p> <p>Wrap up: Ask students what is the meaning of Alhumdulillah? <p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>Identify the Islamic way of cutting nails</p>	<p>Start Up: Begin with dua before lesson. Repeat the dua of going to sleep again and again that students can learn</p> <p></p> <p>Ask student the meaning of bismillah and Alhumdulillah.</p> <p>We Are Learning to: Identify the Islamic way of cutting nails and importance of cutting nails</p> <p>What I am looking for: how well you understand the importance of cutting nails in Sunnah way.</p> <p>Gained skill: This will help us to improve our knowledge about Islamic values</p> <p>Introduction: play video</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=xHLvPnIFybk</p> <p>Ask students do you remember the ways of personal hygiene? Brushing teeth, washing hands, bathing daily, combing hairs and cutting nails are the ways of taking care of ourselves. As we are Muslims so Prophet of Allah Muhammad (PBUH) told us an Islamic way of cutting our nails. It is very important to cut our nails after 15 days. Long nails can trap germs and dirt and you and other people can get scratches due to long nails. Our hands look beautiful when we trim our nails properly. Tell students the way of cutting nails by giving them to hands cutting with paper and long paper nails pasted on them. Tell students today we will learn what Islamic way to cut nails is. Demonstrate to start with right hand forefinger, then middle, ring finger and little finger. Then move to the left hand and start from little finger to ring, middle and fore finger and the thumb. In the end cut the right hand thumb. Focused practice: ask students to open book page 16. Tell them see the way of cutting nails. Tell them we should clean our nails when we wash our hands. Encourage them take nail stickers from page 63 and paste on fingers on page 17. Tell them that clean nails keep us healthy.

Wrap up: Ask students to come one by one and demonstrate how to cut the nails.

Reflection :

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
