Learning Outcomes	Activity Plan/Methodology	Assessment of Learning	Resources
<p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>Identify the letter sound of 'f'</p>	<p><b>Recap:</b> Show previously learnt letters flashcards a, b, c, d, e and ask their sounds.</p> <p><b>Introduction:</b> Show letter 'f' flashcard and utter /f/ sound loud in the class and ask students to repeat it. Play letter 'f' song and ask students to listen it carefully.</p> <p><a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Ij8AQpwpvzl">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Ij8AQpwpvzl</a></p> <div data-bbox="279 438 720 690" data-label="Image"> <p>The flashcard for the letter 'f' includes the following text and illustration:</p> <p><b>f</b> (Tune: Old MacDonald Track 17)</p> <p>My friends and I went to the beach with my floating fish. It got a hole... ...the air came out. /fffff/!</p> <p><b>Action:</b> Let your hands come together gently, as if an inflatable fish is deflating, and say /fffff/.</p> <p>The illustration shows a colorful fish with a hole in its side, surrounded by other fish and a beach scene.</p> </div> <p>Introduce the action and ask students to repeat after you. Bring hands together as if the fish is deflating making a fffffff sound. Practice sound as much as you can.</p> <p>Story of small letter 'f'</p> <p>Once there was a pretty fairy. She lives in a big palace. She has five fish in her aquarium. She likes to play football in the lawn of her palace. There are beautiful flowers in her lawn. She saw four frogs hopping high and she got furious.</p> <p><b>Formation :</b></p> <p>Show how to form letter f (E.g. curve up and go down.) on the board. Ask students to form 'f' in the air, on back of your friend, on your palm, on your knee and on the table and repeat sound f f f f f.</p> <p>Ask students to open book page 6. Read and ask students to repeat after you.</p> <p>/f/ /f/ fish /f/ /f/ frog /f/ /f/ foot /f/ /f/ flute</p> <p><b>Wrap up:</b> Show the flashcard. Repeat the sound and action.</p> <p><b>Reflection :</b></p>	<p>Students will be assessed on Identifying the letter sound of 'f'</p>	<p>Flash cards</p>
