Learning Outcomes	Activity Plan/Methodology	Assessment of Learning	Resources
<p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>Identify the letter sound of 'h'</p>	<p><b>Recap:</b> Show previously learnt letters flashcards a, b, c, d, e, f, g and ask their sounds.</p> <p><b>Introduction:</b> Show letter 'h' flashcard and utter /h/ sound loud in the class and ask students to repeat it. Play letter 'h' song and ask students to listen it carefully.</p> <p><a href="https://youtu.be/pKyDI2IurqI">https://youtu.be/pKyDI2IurqI</a></p> <p>Introduce the action and ask students to repeat after you. Act as panting after a race, holding hands up to mouth and saying h h h h h Practice sound as much as you can.</p> <p>Story of small letter 'h'</p> <p>Haider's father gave him a beautiful hat and helicopter. He was very happy and say Hurrah! He made a heart card for his father to say thank you. His father hugged him, then he told his father that he saw a movie of hippo and horse.</p> <p><b>Formation :</b></p> <p>Show how to form letter h (E.g. long line down, draw a hump.) on the board. Ask students to form 'h' in the air, on back of your friend, on your palm, on your knee and on the table and repeat sound h h h h h.</p> <p>Ask students to open book page 8. Read and ask students to repeat after you.</p> <p>/h/ /h/ hat /h/ /h/ hut /h/ /h/ horse /h/ /h/ hammer</p> <p><b>Wrap up:</b> Show the flashcard. Repeat the sound and action.</p> <p><b>Reflection :</b></p>	<p>Students will be assessed on Identifying the letter sound of 'h'</p>	<p>Flash cards</p>
