<p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>Identify the letter sound of 'u'</p>	<p>Recap: Show previously learnt letters flashcards a, b, c, d, e, f, g, h, i, j, k, l, m, n, o, p, q, r, s, t and ask their sounds.</p> <p>Introduction: Show letter 'u' flashcard and utter /u/ sound loud in the class and ask students to repeat it. Play letter 'u' song and ask students to listen it carefully. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=v4WNLbpNDAg</p> <p></p> <p></p> <p>Introduce the action and ask students to repeat after you. Make upward motion with hand, as if putting up an umbrella saying u u u u u. Practice sound as much as you can.</p> <p>Story of small letter 'u'</p> <p>Uncle Ulu has a large, colourful umbrella. He always keeps his umbrella with him whether it sunny or rainy day. One day he forgot to take his umbrella, he was very unhappy. When he reached home, he saw his umbrella under the sofa</p> <p>Formation: Show how to form letter u (e.g. cup, short line down) on the board. Ask students to form 'u' in the air, on back of your friend, on your palm, on your knee, make letter with play dough, on salt tray and on the table and repeat sound u, u, u, u.</p> <p>Ask students to open book page 21.
