<p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>long vowel 'u' (oo)</p>	<p>Recap: Write long vowel u (u-e, ue) words on board and ask students to read and tell which long vowel sound, is in these words.</p> <p>Introduction: Play video : https://youtu.be/ONggpexO8gY</p> <p>Show the students the flash card 'oo', and repeat the /oo/ sound these two letters make, encouraging the children to join in. Show them the 'moon' card and say: Is there a man in the moon? Draw a full moon on the board and add a face. Say, Here's the man in the moon, encouraging the children to join in. Practice with more words book, wood, zoo, foot, and hook. Tell students that oo has long vowel u sound.</p> <p>Focused Task:</p> <p>Write /oo/ sound words on the board and invite students to come and circle long vowel u sound. Encourage students to blend the sounds to make words (school, room, balloon, boot, roof, cool, zoo, foot, fool, and tooth). Give blank paper, letter flash cards and round shaped cereal to students. Ask them to make /oo/ words with given materials</p> <p>Ask students to open book page 26. Read the phonics jingle and encourage students to repeat after you.</p> <p>Niko stood on the roof, to look for his boot, sudden a dog barked Woof, Woof!</p> <p>/oo/, /oo/, /oo/</p> <p>Paste long 'u (oo)' picture flashcard on board and ask students to write any 5 in copy.</p> <p>Wrap up:</p> <p>Ask students to tell some long u (oo) words.</p> <p>Reflection:</p>	<p>Students will be assessed on Identifying long vowel 'u' (oo)</p>	<p>Flashcard</p>
