<p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>Revise the alphabet Mm- Rr sounds and vocabulary</p>	<p>Recap: Students will be to read aloud letters Aa-Zz. Ask students clap along or pat their laps as they read aloud.</p> <p>Introduction: Tell students today we are going to revise our letters Mm-Rr. Show letters randomly and ask their names and sounds. Encourage students to tell at least 3 words with shown letter e.g. s snake, sun, and strawberry. Practice with initial, middle and ending sound. E.g. orange, pot. Ask students to write letters Mm-Rr in the air repeatedly for few minutes. A few students can asked to come up and write the letters on the board.</p> <p>Focused Task: Place letters flashcards Mm-Rr on the floor and their picture flashcard in a cloth bag. Ask students to come close to you one by one, pick any card from the bag. Tell the picture name and pick the beginning letter of that picture. Note: there should be more than one picture flashcard of each letter with beginning, middle or ending sound. Ask students to open phonics jingles book and encourage them to read aloud Mm-Rr jingles page 8-10 . Ask them to clap three times while saying each sound.</p> <p>Wrap up: Show picture flashcard and ask students its beginning, middle or ending sound.</p> <p>Reflection :</p>	<p>Students will be assessed on Identifying the alphabet Mm-Rr sounds and vocabulary</p>	<p>Flashcard</p>
