Learning Outcomes	Activity Plan/Methodology	Assessment of Learning	Resources
<p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>Revise the alphabet w-z sounds and vocabulary</p>	<p>Recap: Students will be to read aloud letters Aa-Zz. Ask students clap along or pat their laps as they read aloud.</p> <p>Introduction: Teacher will play abc song video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KDtGkO3oPsk</p> <p>Tell students today we are going to revise our letters Aa-Zz. Show letters Aa-Zz randomly and ask their names and sounds. Reinforce w-z sounds thrice. Practice with initial, middle and ending sound. Ask students to write letters Ww to Zz in the air repeatedly for few minutes. A few students can be asked to come up and write the letters on the board.</p> <p>Focused Task: Ask students to close their eyes and turn their backs so they cannot see what you are doing. Take a picture flashcard, and hide it somewhere in the classroom (behind a curtain, on a chair seat, under a book, etc.). Then shout, "Go!" and students race around the classroom looking for that picture flashcard. The student who finds it yells it out and wins a point. This can done a picture at a time or with a number of pictures at the same time.</p> <p>Ask students to open phonics jingles book and encourage them to read aloud Ww-Zz jingles page 13, 14. Ask them to clap three times while saying each sound.</p> <p>Wrap up: Show picture flashcard and ask students its beginning, middle or ending sound.</p> <p>Reflection :</p>	<p>Students will be assessed on Identifying the alphabet w-z sounds and vocabulary</p>	<p>Flashcard</p>
