| <p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>Identify the letter sound of 'b' as initial and ending sound</p> | <p>Recap: Show small and capital letter and ask which is small / which is capital? Ask sound.</p> <p>Introduction: Show letter 'b' flashcard and utter /b/ sound loud in the class and ask students to repeat it. Play letter 'b' story and song. Ask students to listen it carefully. (Note: teacher can either play the video or can tell a story) https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QxZRC+xydNs</p>  <p>Story line for the 'b' sound: Some children go to the park and play ball. As the bat hits the ball it makes a b sound.</p> <p>Flash Card: Teacher shows the capital and small letter 'Bb'. Show capital B, say the letter name. Show small b, say the letter sound.</p> <p>Action: Ask students to pretend to hold a bat and hit a ball saying b b b. Show them the correct formation of the letter by thinking of the down stroke of the b as the bat and the round part of the b as the ball. They hit the ball along the line, with the bat, when writing.</p> <p>Letter Formation: Teacher shows how to form the small letter 'b' (e.g.' long line down, circle to the right) Show how to form capital letter B (e.g... long line down, circle to the right, circle to the right) tell them it is a sky letter. Children form the letter in the air.</p> <p>Focused Task: Ask students to open book page 4. Read the rhyme and ask students to repeat after you. Butterfly blows big bubbles /b/ /b//b/ Help students to read words given on page 5. Help them to identify 'b' as initial sound and ending sound. Write words like bag and bib on board and ask students to identify and circle the 'b' as initial and ending sound.</p> <p>Wrap up: Show the flashcard. Repeat the sound and action.</p> <p>Reflection :</p> | <p>Students will be assessed on identifying letter sound of 'b' as initial and ending sound</p> | <p>Flash cards</p> |
