


Letter 'Mm'

Class: Nursery

Learning Outcomes	Activity Plan/Methodology	Assessment of Learning	Resources
<p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>Identify the letter sound of 'm' as initial and ending sound</p>	<p><b>Start Up:</b> Show small and capital letter and ask which is small / which is capital? Ask sound.</p> <p><b>Introduction:</b> Show letter 'm' flashcard and utter /m/ sound loud in the class and ask students to repeat it. Play letter 'm' story and song. Ask students to listen it carefully. (Note: teacher can either play the video or can tell a story)</p> <p><a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kvfsHK4-dgQ">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kvfsHK4-dgQ</a></p>  <p><b>Storyline for the 'm' sound:</b> The children tell the class what their favourite meal is. Each time a child describes their favourite meal, they rub their tummies and say mmmmmmm.</p> <p><b>Flash Card:</b> Teacher shows the letter Mm both capital and small.</p> <p><b>Action:</b> ask students to rub tummy and say mmmmmmm.</p> <p><b>Letter Formation:</b> Teacher shows how to form the small letter m (e.g. short line down, draw a hump, and draw a hump). Show how to form capital letter M (e.g... up down, up down). Students will form the letter in the air'. Tell students that 'm' is a grass letter and it is written in middle two lines.</p> <p><b>Focused Task:</b> Ask students to open book page 26. Read the rhyme and ask students to repeat after you.</p> <p><b>Mickey and Minnie munch on mangoes, and mulberries in the morning /m/ /m/ /m/</b></p> <p>Help students to read words given on page 27. Help them to identify 'm' as initial and ending sound. Write words like monkey, moon and jam, plum on board and ask students to identify and circle the 'm' as initial and ending sound.</p> <p><b>Wrap up:</b> Show the words flashcards and ask students to tell the beginning and ending sound.</p> <p><b>Reflection :</b></p>	<p>Students will be assessed on Identifying the letter sound of 'm' as initial and ending sound</p>	<p>Flash cards</p>
