Learning Outcomes	Activity Plan/Methodology	Assessment of Learning	Resources
<p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>Identify the letter sound of 'n' as initial and ending sound</p>	<p>Start Up: Show small and capital letter and ask which is small / which is capital? Ask sound.</p> <p>Introduction: Show letter 'n' flashcard and utter /n/ sound loud in the class and ask students to repeat it. Play letter 'n' story and song. Ask students to listen it carefully. (Note: teacher can either play the video or can tell a story) https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tHquDGa-UH8</p>  <p>Storyline for the 'n' sound: The child has a model aero plane and goes out to fly it. There is a lot of noise as it takes off. It goes round and round making a nnnnnnnnn sound, but then it goes out of control and nosedives, making a louder nnnnnnnnnnnnnnn sound. The aero plane then pulls out of the nosedive and lands safely.</p> <p>Action: ask students to put their arms out and pretend to be the aero plane making a continuous nnnnnnnnnnnnn sound.</p> <p>Letter Formation: Teacher shows how to form the small letter n (e.g. short line down, draw a hump). Show how to form capital letter N (e.g.. up, down, up). Students will form the letter in the air'. Tell students that 'n' is a grass letter and it is written in middle two lines.</p> <p>Focused Task: Ask students to open book page 28. Read the rhyme and ask students to repeat after you.</p> <p>Nany and Nancy make noise in the part at noon. /n/ /n/ /n/</p> <p>Help students to read words given on page 29. Help them to identify 'n' as initial and ending sound. Write words like nose, nut and pen, ten on board and ask students to identify and circle the 'n' as initial and ending sound.</p> <p>Wrap up: Show the words flashcards and ask students to tell the beginning and ending sound.</p> <p>Reflection :</p>	<p>Students will be assessed on Identifying the letter sound of 'n' as initial and ending sound</p>	<p>Flash cards</p>
