


Learning Outcomes	Activity Plan/Methodology	Assessment of Learning	Resources
<p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>Identify the letter sound of 'v' as initial and ending sound</p>	<p><b>Start Up:</b> Show small and capital letter and ask which is small / which is capital? Ask sound.</p> <p><b>Introduction:</b> Show letter 'v' flashcard and utter /v/ sound loud in the class and ask students to repeat it. Play letter 'v' story and song. Ask students to listen it carefully. (Note: teacher can either play the video or can tell a story)</p> <p><a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=s+RNqOrhHBU">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=s+RNqOrhHBU</a></p>  <p><b>Storyline for the 'v' sound:</b> Uncle Vic arrives in a van and asks if the children would like to come with him to pick up some people from the station. He drives around dropping people off at their houses. As he drives, the children make a vvvvvvv sound.</p> <p><b>Flashcard:</b> Show the letter Vv both capital and small.</p> <p><b>Action:</b> ask students to pretend to be driving, holding the steering wheel and saying vvvvvvvvvvv.</p> <p><b>Letter Formation:</b> Teacher shows how to form the small letter v (e.g. diagonal line down, diagonal line up). Show how to form capital letter V (e.g. diagonal line down, diagonal line up). Students will form the letter in the air'. Tell students that 'v' is a grass letter.</p> <p><b>Focused Task:</b> Ask students to open book page 44. Read the rhyme and ask students to repeat after you.  <b>A vet wears vest drives van and watches the volcano video. /v/ /v/ /v/</b></p> <p>Help students to read words given on page 45. Help them to identify 'v' as initial and ending sound. Write words like vase, violin and dove, five on board and ask students to identify and circle the 'v' as initial and ending sound.</p> <p><b>Wrap up:</b>  Show the words flashcards and ask students to tell the beginning and ending sound.</p> <p><b>Reflection :</b></p>	<p>Students will be assessed on identifying the letter sound of 'v' as initial and ending sound</p>	<p>Flash cards</p>
