<p>Upon the completion of this lesson, Students will be able to:</p> <p>Identify the letter sound of 'x' as middle and ending sound</p>	<p>Start Up: Show small and capital letter and ask which is small / which is capital? Ask sound.</p> <p>Introduction: Show letter 'x' flashcard and utter /x/ sound loud in the class and ask students to repeat it. Play letter 'x' story and song. Ask students to listen it carefully. (Note: teacher can either play the video or can tell a story)</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6oBdjl9Oz7Q</p> <div data-bbox="289 505 428 646"> <p>X (Tune: Skip to My Lou Track 30)</p> <p>/ks-/ks/! Take an x-ray. /kf-/kf/! Take an x-ray. /kf-/kf/! Take an x-ray -x-ray of my hand!</p> <p><small>Action: Pretend to take an x-ray with an x-ray camera, saying ks, ks, ks.</small></p> </div>  <p>Storyline for the 'x' sound: A child has fallen and hurt their hand: They have an x-ray taken to see if a bone has been broken.</p> <p>Flash Card: Teacher shows the letter 'Xx' both capital and small.</p> <p>Action: ask students to pretend to take an x-ray picture, pointing the camera and saying /ks, /ks. The children can be told that the letter 'x' makes two sounds, k-s.</p> <p>Letter Formation: The Teacher shows how to form the small letter x (e.g. diagonal right, diagonal left). Show how to form capital letter x (e.g. diagonal right, diagonal left). Students will form the letter in the air'. Tell students that 'x' is grass letter.</p> <p>Focused Task: Ask students to open book page 48. Read the rhyme and ask students to repeat after you.</p> <p>Max cut woods with axe /x/ /x/</p> <p>Help students to read words given on page 49. Help them to identify 'x' as middle and ending sound. Write words like box, fox, taxi on board and ask students to identify and circle the 'x' as middle and ending sound</p> <p>Wrap up: show the words flashcards and ask students to tell the middle and ending sound.</p> <p>Reflection :</p>	<p>Students will be assessed on identifying the letter sound of 'x' as middle and sound</p>	<p>Flash cards</p>
