Lighthouses have stood on or near the beaches of coastal areas for millennia. They help ship captains to know the position of their ships both day and night. A lighthouse also warns ship captains if they are too near to land or of dangerous rock and ice-bergs in the water. In the day time, a lighthouse can be recognized by its simple tower like structure.

Sometimes fog rolls in thick over the ocean and neither the lighthouse nor the flashing light can be seen. If this happens, the lighthouse keeper may sound a foghorn. The foghorn's sound disperse over the waters. It lets the people navigating great steamships and smaller boats know which way to go to get through the fog.

Inside the lighthouse tower, there is a long stairway and walkway around the outside of light. It is also from the walkway that giant glass windows are kept clean on the outside so that the light shines at its brightest.
