S.P. He took good care of his health.

Future: He will take good care of his health.

Neg: He does not take good care of his health.

S.P. They played soccer on the weekends.

Future: They will play soccer on the weekends.

Neg: They do not play soccer on the weekends.

Interro: Do they play soccer on the weekends?

iii) I read the newspaper before work.

S.P. I read the newspaper before work.

Future: I will read the newspaper before work.

Neg: I do not read the newspaper before work.

Interro: Do I read the newspaper before work?

n) She brushes her teeth twice a day.

S.P: She brushed her teeth twice a day.

Future: She will brush her teeth twice a day.

Neg: She does not brush her teeth twice a day.

Interro: Does she brush her teeth twice a day?
