

Rocks found in Pakistan:

Pakistan has huge reserves of salt, marble, China clay, shale sandstone and limestone. Salt: Pakistan is blessed with millions of tons of rock salt reserves. The largest reserve of rock salt is in Khewra. Khewra is located in the north of Jhelum city in Punjab province. Khewra salt mine is the second-largest salt mine in the world. This mine produce around 325,000 tons of salt per annum. Interestingly, the overall salt in the mine is calculated to be around 6.687 billion tons. The salt mine cover 110 square kilometers, with a total depth of 228 meters or 758 feet. The temperature inside the salt mines remains consistent, around 18°C to 20°C throughout the year.
