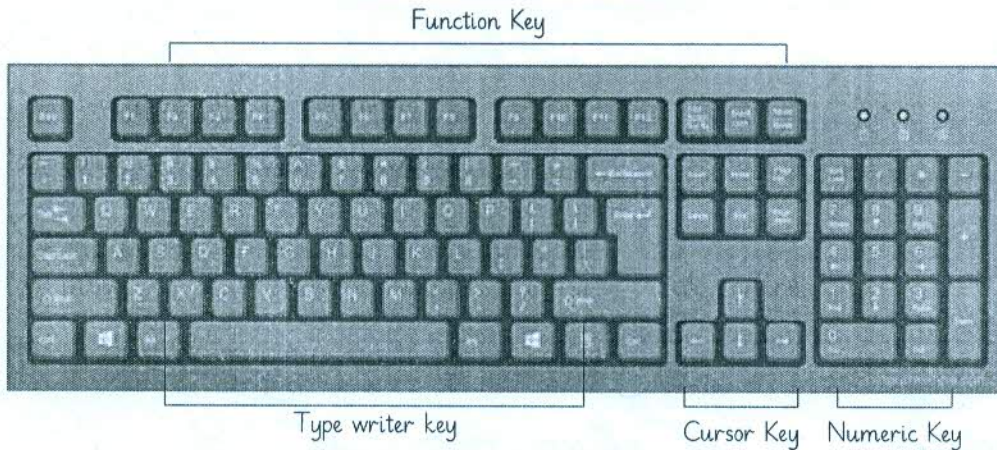


Input & Output Devices



Keyboard (wired, wireless, virtual) is the most common input device used today. The individual keys for letters, numbers and special character are collectively known as character keys. The layout of keyboard is like that of traditional typewriter. Keyboard are of two sizes, 84 keys or 101/102 keys, but now keyboards with 104/108 keys are also available.
